

Advanced Practice Provider (APP): Nurse Practitioner (NP) Privileges Form

NPs are entitled to exercise only those privileges specifically granted to her/him/them. The UCSF Office of Medical Affairs and Governance (OMAG) identifies approved privileges on the [ECHO website](#).

A period of [Focused Professional Practice Evaluation \(FPPE\)](#) is required for all new privileges, including core privileges. The FPPE evaluates and confirms the current competency of a practitioner's performance of privileges and professionalism at UCSF. The UCSF APP FPPE process includes submitting logs through the [UCMe e-Log system](#).

CORE Core Privileges

- BASIC Core NP Privileges** (These privileges apply to all NPs)
Level of Supervision by a Medical Staff Member: Indirect
 Initial and ongoing assessment of a patient's medical, physical, and psychosocial status including:
1. Completing histories and physical examinations
 2. Developing treatment plans, goals of care, and advanced care plans
 3. Performing daily rounds
 4. Establishing primary and secondary diagnoses as well as determining complications, comorbidities, and present on admission conditions
 5. Providing general or specialty consultation to other providers
 6. Documenting patient care in the electronic health record as required by medical center policies and procedures
 7. Ordering diagnostic tests, monitoring, and therapeutic modalities such as medications, treatments, and examinations
 8. Obtaining informed consent for blood and blood products
 9. Initiating referrals to appropriate physicians or other healthcare professionals
 10. Instructing, educating, and counseling patients and families concerning health status, results of tests, disease processes, and discharge instructions
 11. Planning discharges and writing discharge summaries
 12. Ordering rehab and respiratory therapy
 13. Ordering durable medical equipment
 14. Ordering home health services and supplies
 15. Determining disability and work status
 16. Declaring cardiopulmonary death (NOT brain death) of patients with comfort care orders
 17. Completing and attesting to the medical and health sections of death certificates when the NP is last provider in attendance on a decedent in accordance with [California Assembly Bill No. 583](#)

May not be the admitting provider of record

Core Privileges are granted based on license type after successful completion of the UCSF credentialing and privileging processes.

Initial Criteria:

Formal Training: Graduation from a California Board of Registered Nursing approved or verified school of nursing with a master's degree in nursing or Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP)

AND

NP National Board Certification: Current certification appropriate to the specialty, setting, and patient population from the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), American Association of Critical-Care Nurses (AACN), American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Board (AANPCB), Pediatric Nursing Certification Board (PNCB), or National Certification Corporation (NCC)

AND

Current California Registered Nurse (RN) License without restriction

AND

Current California Nurse Practitioner (NP) Certification without restriction

AND

Current California Nurse Practitioner Furnishing Number

AND

Current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) certification

AND

Current American Heart Association ACLS/PALS/NRP as required based on specific privileges, patient population, and clinical area

AND

Current Emergency Neurological Life Support (ENLS) if on primary service in adult critical care medicine

AND

Experience as an NP and two Peer References (satisfactory or better) OR establishment of a UCSF Level II Focused Professional Practice Evaluation (FPPE)

Assessment of competency will be conducted by the supervising physician or their designee through the FPPE process (level I or II based on prior clinical experience as an NP and peer references) until the level of performance is determined to be at least meets expectations (satisfactory) in all domains.

Maintenance/Renewal Criteria:

Maintenance of NP National Board Certification appropriate to the specialty, setting, and patient population from the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), American Association of Critical-Care Nurses (AACN), American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Board (AANPCB), Pediatric Nursing Certification Board (PNCB), or National Certification Corporation (NCC).

Maintenance of unrestricted California RN License, NP Certification, and NP Furnishing Number

Maintenance of American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS)

Maintenance of American Heart Association ACLS/PALS/NRP as required based on specific privileges, patient population, and clinical area

Continuing Medical Education: Documentation of compliance with the Board of Registered Nursing of California CEU requirements for re-licensure. Educational activities must relate, in part, to the privileges requested and granted

AND

Competency Assessment: Current demonstrated competence and documentation of successful treatment to a minimum of patients, set forth by the Chair/Chief of Department, for the past 24 months based on results of quality assessment/improvement activities and outcomes

Complete core privilege and standardized procedure [UCMe e-Logs](#).

MEDICATION

Administer, dispense, furnish, order, and prescribe medications within the NP's scope of practice and consistent with the NP's education, training, competence, professional judgment, clinical practice, and policies of the medical center. The medications must be included in the UCSF e-Formulary, the patient's insurance formulary, peer-reviewed medical literature, a research protocol including all the standard elements, or a patient's home medications or supplements without known risk of harm. For each medication, a justification must be written in the electronic health record.

PICU	Critical Care Pediatrics (neonatal, infants, children, and adolescents) Evaluate, diagnose, and provide treatment/management of life-threatening disorders or injuries for children in intensive care units. Assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of pediatric patients with emergent conditions consistent with medical staff policy regarding emergency and consultative call services. <u>Initial Criteria:</u> American Heart Association BLS and PALS certification <u>Maintenance/Renewal Criteria:</u> Maintenance of American Heart Association BLS and PALS certification
PEDT	Pediatric Emergency Transport

For patients being admitted to a Pediatric Unit, from age birth to 18 years and adults with congenital conditions and/or conditions that typically arise during childhood. Includes both air and ground transport, as well as medical management at referring hospital

Neonatal

Initial and ongoing assessment of pediatric patients in the Intensive Care Nursery (ICN) for the patient's medical, physical, and psychosocial status including taking and recording history, analyzing history and physical information to develop appropriate differential diagnoses, ordering and interpreting diagnostic tests, physical and occupational therapies, and examinations. Administration of medications and performing advanced procedures and delivery room resuscitation.

Instruct, educate, and counsel families concerning health status, results of tests, disease processes, and discharge plans, write/dictate discharge summaries, initiate referrals to appropriate physician or other healthcare professionals
