- CAT 1 Basic Privileges
 - A GENERAL DENTISTRY: Patient mgmt (with OMFS and medical consultants), including H&Ps (with a medical consultant), diagnostic and therapeutic treatments, procedures and interventions, and similar activities inc. in Cat 3A, 3G02, 3H or 3E02 if applicable.

Criteria: Requires a level of training, skill and ability generally associated with persons who have completed the training program prescribed by the Council on Dental Education of the American Dental Association.

B PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY: Patient mgmt (with the Pediatric Service) inc. H&Ps (with the Pediatric Svce) diagnostic and therapeutic treatments, procedures and interventions and similar activities inc. in Cat 3A or 3G02 if applicable Criteria: Requires a level of training, skill and ability generally associated with persons who have completed the training program in Pediatric Dentistry prescribed by the Council on Dental Education of the American Dental Association.

C ORAL AND MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY: Patient management, including admission history and physical examination for surgical procedures, diagnostic and therapeutic treatments, procedures and interventions, and similar activities in Cat 3 if applicable.

Criteria: Requires a level of training, skill and ability generally associated with persons who have completed the training program in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery prescribed by the Council on Dental Education of the American Dental Association.

D ORAL PATHOLOGY: Management of oral biopsy specimens and similar activites included in Cat 3K if applicable

Criteria: Requires a level of training, skill and ability associated with persons who have completed a training program in Oral Pathology prescribed by the Council on Dental Education of the American Dental Association.

E PERIODONTICS: Patient management, (with OMFS and medical consultants) inc. H&Ps (with medical consultant), diagnostic and therapeutic treatments, procedures and interventions, and similar activities inc. in Cat 3A, 3C04, 3E02, 3G02, 3J, 3H if applicable

Criteria: Requires a level of training, skill and ability generally associated with persons who have completed the training program in Periodontics prescribed by the Council on Dental Education of the American Dental Association.

- B SURGERY OF TEETH AND JAWS
- 2 Benign tumors or cysts with reconstruction
- 4 Malignant tumors, limited to diagnostic procedures, local resection and reconstruction, with consultation from the appropriate surgical service for treatment of malignant tumors involving the need for radical neck or composite resection
- 6 Minor infection of teeth, jaws
- 8 Major infection of teeth, jaws, with consultation from the appropriate surgical service when the infection involves deep fascial spaces of the neck
- 10 Foreign bodies and repair of defects
- C PREPROSTHETIC SURGERY
- 2 With musosal, skin, or bone grafts
- 4 Placement of implants
- D ORTHOGNATHIC SURGERY
- 2 With bone, mucosal or skin grafting
- E TREATMENT OF TEMPOROMANDIBULAR JOINT DISORDERS
- 2 Nonsurgical
- 4 Surgical
- 6 Arthroscopic (LASER)
- F TRAUMA
- 2 Fractures of the maxilla and mandible, with consultation from the appropriate surgical subspecialty service, when such fractures are associated with fractures of the frontal bones, orbit or larynx
- 4 Repair of oral and lip lacerations
- G ANESTHESIA
- 2 Local blocks of sensory nerves of head and neck
- 4 Moderate sedation
- 6 Deep sedation/general anesthesia
- H LASER SURGERY
- 2 Surgical CO2 laser
- 4 Nd/Yag Laser (LASER)

- I MICROSURGERY
- 2 Inferior alveolar, lingual, and infraorbital nerves
- J PERIODONTICS
- 2 Non-surgical and surgical periodontal treatment
- K ORAL PATHOLOGY
- 2 Microscopic diagnosis of oral biopsies
- L Fluoroscopy (formal fluoroscopy supervisor certification required)
