CAT 1 Basic Privileges:

A Basic Pathology Privileges

Patient care responsibilities, including diagnostic procedures and interventions, requiring a level of training generally associated with persons who have completed a residency training program in Clinical Pathology or Anatomic & Clinical Pathology prescribed by the American Board of Pathology. Patient Care responsibilities encompass supervision and direction of the specimen collection, analysis and the reporting and interpretation of results of diagnostic tests in Blood Banking/Transfusion Medicine/Immunology, Clinical Chemistry, Hematology, Immunology, Microbiology/Virology, Molecular Diagnostics, Medical Informatics, Laboratory Management and similar activities requiring the same level of training, skill and ability.

Individuals who do not qualify for Basic Pathology Privileges indicated above covering all aspects of laboratory medicine may indicate their specific areas of privileging from the following list in Limited Basic Privileges below.

B Limited Basic Privileges

Patient care responsibilities, including diagnostic procedures and interventions for physicians who are board certified in other specialties and who, by virtue of experience or training, demonstrate a level of skill and ability equivalent to persons who are diplomates of the American Board of Pathology, its subspecialty board(s) or equivalent certifying specialty board(s) in the area(s) requested below.

1 Blood Banking/Transfusion Medicine/Immunochemistry

2 Clinical Chemistry

3 Hematology (excluding Bone Marrow Interpretation)

4 Immunology

5 Laboratory Management

6 Medical Informatics and Data Processing

7 Microbiology/Virology

8 Molecular Diagnostics

C Cytogenetics

Patient care responsibilities, including diagnostic procedures and interventions requiring a level of training generally associated with persons who have completed a fellowship in cytogenetics, clinical cytogenetics and/or molecular cytogenetics and who are board certified or board eligible by the American Board of Pathology in Cytogenetics and/or the American Board of Medical Genetics or who by virtue

of experience or training in an allied field demonstrate a level of skill and ability generally associated with persons who are diplomates of those board(s) or equivalent certifying speciality board(s).

CAT 2 Subspecialty Privileges:

Patient care responsibilities, including diagnostic procedures and interventions requiring a level of training generally associated with persons who are board certified or board eligible by the American Board of Pahtology, who have completed a fellowship program in the requested speciality and who are board certified or board eligible for certification in that area.

CAT 3 Limited Privileges:

Patient care responsibilities, including diagnostic procedures and interventions for physicians who are board certified in other specialities and who, by virtue of experience or training, demonstrate a level of skill and ability equivalent to person who are certified by the American Board of Pathology in the subspeciality area(s) indicated below.
