CAT 1 Basic Privileges: Patient management, including H & Ps and diagnostic and therapeutic treatments, procedures and interventions encompassing the areas described below and similar activities.

Requiring a level of training generally associated with persons who have completed the residency program prescribed by the American Board of Internal Medicine, and a level of skill and ability generally associated with persons who are diplomates of that board

- A Basic privileges In general medicine
- B Thoracocentesis
- C Abdominal paracentesis
- D Bone marrow aspiration
- E Bone marrow biopsy
- F Liverbiopsy
- G Sigmoidoscopy, proctoscopy with biopsy
- H Aspiration of joints & subcutaneous lesions
Lumbar puncture
- J Arterial puncture
- K Skin Biopsy

L Central Line Placement & Removal

Criteria: Documented Completion of the Central Venous Catheter Procedure Education and Training Module AND Documentation of at least one of the following: 1. Board Eligibility/Board Certification in specialties that include CVC Insertion and/or removal procedure as part of the basic delineated competencies (ie. Anesthesia, Cardiology, Emergency Medicine, General Surgery, Interventional Radiology and Nephrology). 2. Completion of one-month experience/rotation in Interventional Radiology. 3. Attestation or certification by Service Chief or Program Directors. 4. Documented supervised insertion procedures (5 internal jugular, 5 femoral, 5 PICC, 5 subclavian). Documented supervised removal procedures (2 non-tunneled lines)

M Muscle Biopsy

CAT 2 Subspecialty Privileges: Patient management at this level encompasses Category 1 patient management, the items marked below and similar activities.

- A Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine
 - 1 Basic privileges in pulmonary diseases
 - 2 Fiberoptic bronchoscopy and biopsy
 - 3 Transbronchiallung biopsy

- 4 Pleural biopsy
- 5 Percutaneous lung biopsy
- 6 Pulmonary function studies
- 7 Moderate Sedation
Criteria: Successful completion of Sedation Module Required prior to granting of privileges, and current ACLS Certification.
- 7a Deep Sedation
(For Intensivists Only)
- 8 Insertion of interarterial line
- 9 Insertion of pulmonary catheter
- 10 Endotracheal intubation
- 11 Airway and ventilator management
- 12 Laser therapy of endobronchial lesions
- 13 Sleep Medicine

- E Critical Care Ultrasound for Limited Anatomic Examination
 Initial Appointment: Completion of the UCSF Critical Care Ultrasound Credentialing Pathway or documentation of ultrasound training along with a letter of reference attesting to competency if training completed at outside institution (to be reviewed on case-by-case basis by Critical Care Ultrasound Director)
 Reappointment: Documentation of ongoing use of critical care ultrasound with acceptable accuracy rate as determined by the Critical Care Ultrasound Director.
- 1 Focused Cardiac Ultrasound, Including
- a. Presence or absence of pericardial fluid
 - b. Qualitative assessment of LV and RV size and function
 - c. Assessment of inferior vena cava size and respiratory variation
- 2 Thoracic Ultrasound
- a. Evaluation for pneumothorax
 - b. Evaluation of lung parenchyma for pulmonary edema/consolidation
 - c. Evaluation for pleural effusion
- 3 Abdominal Ultrasound
- a. Focused abdominal sonography in trauma (FAST)
 - b. Evaluation of bladder volume and identification of hydronephrosis
- 4 Examination of vascular structures
- a. Evaluation of lower extremities for DVT
 - b. Evaluation of abdominal aorta.
- CAT 4 Limited Privileges in Medicine: Patient management limited to the areas specified
- A Podiatric practice only (Pamassus only)
 - B Clinical psychology only
 - C Metabolic privileges only
 - D Consultation only
 - E EKG reading only
