CORE Core Privileges

BASIC Core PA Privileges (These privileges apply to all PAs)

Initial and ongoing assessment of a patient's medical, physical, and psychosocial status including:

- 1. Completing histories and physical examinations
- 2. Developing treatment plans, goals of care, and advanced care plans
- 3. Establishing primary and secondary diagnoses as well as determining complications, comorbidities, and present on admission conditions
- 4. Providing general or specialty consultation to other providers
- 5. Performing daily rounds
- 6. Recording of progress notes as required by the medical center policies and Procedure
- 7. Ordering diagnostic tests, monitoring, and therapeutic modalities, such as medications, treatments, and examinations.
- 8. Initiating referrals to appropriate physicians or other healthcare professionals
- 9. Instructing, educating, and counseling patients and families concerning health status, test results, disease processes, and discharge instructions.
- 10. Planning discharges and writing discharge summaries
- 11. Ordering rehab and respiratory therapy
- 12. Ordering durable medical equipment
- 13. Ordering home health services and supplies
- 14. Determining disability and work status
- 15. First assist in surgical procedures

Initial Criteria:

Provisional core privileges are granted based on license type and successfully completing the UCSF credentialing process.

Core privileges are granted after the APP has demonstrated competency through the FPPE process and submitted at least five activity logs via the <a href="https://www.ucman.com/

PICU CRITICAL CARE PEDIATRICS (neonatal, infants, children, and adolescents)

Assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of pediatric patients with emergent conditions consistent with medical staff policy regarding emergency and consultative call services.

PEDT PEDIATRIC EMERGENCY TRANSPORT

Demonstrated competence in intubation, arterial line placement, thoracentesis, and chest tube placement before completion of orientation and going on transport without a preceptor.

NEO NEONATAL

Initial and ongoing assessment of pediatric patients in the Intensive Care Nursery for the patient's medical, physical and psychosocial status including taking and recording history, analyzing history and physical information to develop an appropriate differential diagnosis, ordering and interpreting diagnostic tests, physical and occupational therapies, examination. Administration of medications and performing advanced procedures and delivery room resuscitation.

Instruct, educate, and counsel families concerning health status, results of tests, disease process and discharge planning, writing/dictating of discharge summaries, initiate referral to appropriate physician or other healthcare professional
